#### **Attendance Policy**

At our recent Governing Body meeting Governors adopted our new Attendance Policy (which can be found in the Policies section of our school web site). The main change in the policy states:

If the child has accrued **7 days or more** of unauthorised absence in a maximum 12 school week rolling period, the parents could receive:

- A warning requiring them to ensure no further unauthorised absences occur in a 15 school day monitoring period, otherwise you would receive a fine.
- A fine the warning period does not apply to notices issued due to holidays in term time taken without permission.

  Please consider this when asking for Leave of Absence in term time.

#### **Spellodrome**

We currently have a free trail of Spellodrome – a spelling programme developed by the makers of Mathletics. Children can access Spellodrome using their Mathletics log on details. We will evaluate the impact and usefulness after our trial period has finished.
