#### Bottle Festoon - Lumiere Durham 2019

Bottle Festoon is a unique and eco-friendly artwork of glittering, icicle-like chandeliers made from clear or green plastic bottles. Each chandelier will be created by school children, community groups and families, using their plastic bottles from home.

We are working with community groups from across County Durham to help us create this installation which will be featured in the Lumiere Festival.





In the UK 38.5 m plastic bottles are used and discarded every day and only half are recycled. This means that more than 16m bottles are put into landfill, burnt or discarded into our oceans and environment each and every day.

Bottle Festoon creates art out of our plastic waste and draws attention to what we all do with our plastic.

We are asking for support in collecting bottles and there are also a few workshops available for groups to work with us between July and October to help us create the chandeliers.

### Bottle Festoon - Bottle guide

To make the piece as spectacular as possible we need to collect over 8,000 plastic bottles in total and transform them into this amazing installation, so we need help with this mammoth task!

## What works best - see example pictures below.

- Green and clear, we can use other colours too!
- 2 litre plastic bottles work best; however, we can use 1litre and 500ml bottles too
- Washed out make sure nothing sticky is left inside! Just rinse out with hot water and leave to dry
- Labels removed



### What doesn't work - we don't want these please!

Smaller fruit and smoothie bottles, milk cartons, hard plastic bottles, household cleaning, un-washed out bottles.

Each group we are working with will be asked to collect plastic bottles – you need between 30 and 50 plastic bottles to create each chandelier. So please encourage friends, families and colleagues to get involved and get collecting!
