

Parent Governor Vacancies

Our Governing Body currently has two vacancies for Parent Governors. Our Governing Body is an integral part of our Leadership Team in school and provides three core functions: setting the strategic direction, holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and ensuring financial health, probity and value for money. Being a Governor is a rewarding yet voluntary role. Attendance at meetings (normally three or four per term beginning at 5p.m.) and training to strengthen our Governing Body is expected, along with occasional visits to school to speak with children and staff while school is operational. Our Governors are appointed on a skills basis and we currently require Governors with some of the following skills:

- Financial planning/management
- Links with local businesses
- Ability to question and challenge
- Commitment to the school's ethos

If more than two parents are interested in these roles an election of all parents will be held. On appointment new Governors are invited to attend an Induction Meeting and to meet informally with an existing Governor to discuss current school issues. If you are interested in becoming a Governor please contact the school office for an application form. If you would like to discuss the roll further with an existing Governor this can also be arranged. Mrs Swift
