The unit helps to free up space in the school and even houses craft materials and dress up costumes for children to have fun with.

Headteacher Andrea Swift said everyone at the school was thrilled with the pod and are very grateful to Janus. The pod is a welcome addition to the £500,000 extension which was carried out at the Hall Walks school to create muchneeded extra space. Over the years ,the primary building had become too small to house the growing number of children wanting places.
