Training and Information Sessions for Parents/Carers

These training and information sessions have been designed and developed by a parent with experience of supporting a child with emotional and mental health difficulties. Each session will be delivered by a parent and CAMHS Nurse, you will meet other parents who may be going through similar experiences, receive information, advice and practical tips around what might help you and your child. We have also teamed up with the Feel Good Factory so every session will include tips & strategies to help you personally.

All sessions are free and open to any parent, carer or family member who is supporting a child with emotional or mental health difficulties.

Child Questionnaire results

We recently asked our children to compete a questionnaire linked to our school as a church school. We were very pleased with the results:

- 97% are happy at our school
