Sport Premium funding 2016-2017

Sport Premium is an amount of money which the government has agreed to allocate to schools. The funding amount schools receive is based upon the number of children of primary age the school has at January of that year. The sport premium is to be used to increase the quality & breadth of PE & Sport provision, and increasing participation in PE & Sport.

At Easington Church of England Primary School we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils.

The 2016-2017 Sport Premium funding for Easington Church of England Primary School is £8,480

The money is being used to:

- part fund the employment of our PE Subject Leader (a specialist PE teacher) who teaches PE to every class weekly.
- provide transport for children to and from swimming lessons and other sporting events
- purchase Youth Sport Trust membership

Transport for swimming lessons and to other sporting events	£1330
Youth Sport Trust membership	£500
Subject Leader to teach PE in each class	£6650

What we aim to provide that:

- Every child in school receives two lessons of PE teaching every week.
- We participate in and are successful at cluster competitions
- We hold an annual intra-school sports event and this year intend to develop intra-school sports activities to occur every half-term.
- Our Y3/4 children attend weekly swimming lessons.
- Our Y5/6 children are given the opportunity to attend a residential which includes many Outdoor and Adventurous activities.
- Throughout the year we offer a range of PE and sporting After School Clubs for example:

Football Netball Gymnastics Tennis Multi skills Tag Rugby Hockey Cricket Health and Fitness

We have links with Peterlee Tennis Club, Hartlepool United Football Club, Sunderland Football Club, Horden Rugby Club, Durham Athletics association, Easington Colliery cricket club and promote other local sporting clubs.
