Important changes to opening hours:



From Sunday January 5th 2020, Peterlee Urgent Treatment Centre will close from midnight to 8am every day.

During this time, you will no longer be able to walk into the centre for treatment.

Peterlee Urgent Treatment Centre will re-open daily between 8am and midnight.

Care will still be available **locally** between midnight and 8am by calling NHS 111



Conditions that can be treated at any urgent treatment centre include:

- Cuts and grazes
- Sprains and strains
- Simple broken bones
- Wounds and wound infections
- Minor burns and scalds Minor head injuries
- Insect and animal bites
- Minor back injuries
- Skin infections / rashes / allergic reactions
- Urine infections
- Raised temperature/fever
- Minor eye injuries (foreign bodies in eye)
- Emergency contraception
- Abdominal pain
- Vomiting and diarrhoea
- Ear and throat infections
