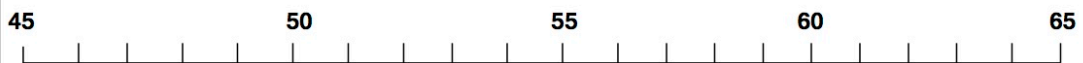
English

Read a book with your family. Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story and label what you have drawn. Maybe you could write a sentence explaining why that is your favourite part.



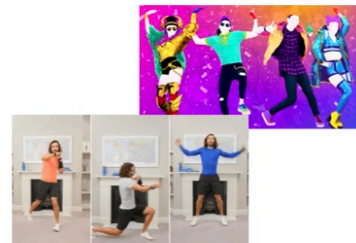
Maths

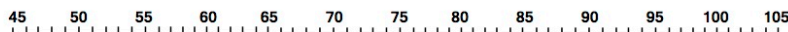
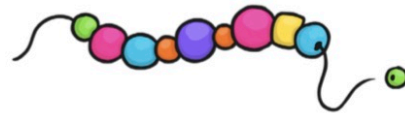
English

Maths

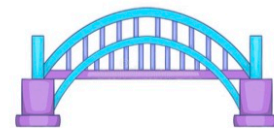
If you count 85 ladybirds in your garden and 21 birds how many animals are in your garden altogether?

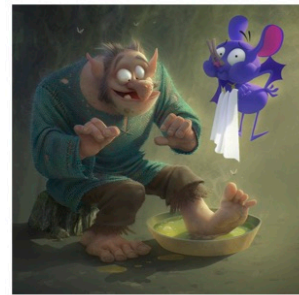
