### Maths

Here is a grid of four boxes.



You must choose four different digits from 1-9 and put one in each box.

5	2
1	9

This gives four different two-digit numbers. 52 (reading along the first row), 19 (reading along the second row), 51 (reading down the left-hand column) and 29 (reading down the right-hand column). In this case, their sum is 151.

Try a few examples of your own.

Is there a quick way to work out if the total will be even or odd?

Your challenge is to find four different digits that make four different 2-digit numbers which add to a total of 100. Can you make 100? How many ways can you find of doing it?
