

Complete the pyramids - the two numbers below make the number above using one of the four operations $(+, -, x, \div)$. First, you will need to work out which operation the pyramid is using.

Practise receiving high hit balls for summer games.

Throw a ball up in the air above your head and catch it.



Next time you throw, clap your hands before you catch. Increase the number of claps by one each time you throw so you have to throw the ball higher and higher in order to fit in the claps.
