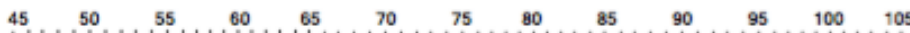
English

Got to find Easter eggs

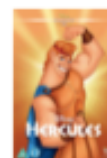
Maths

Maths

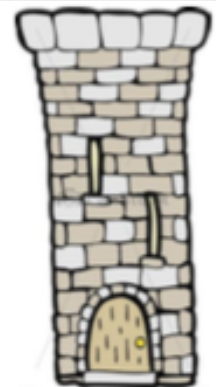
If you count 107 ladybirds in your garden and 17 fly away, how many ladybirds are left?
