

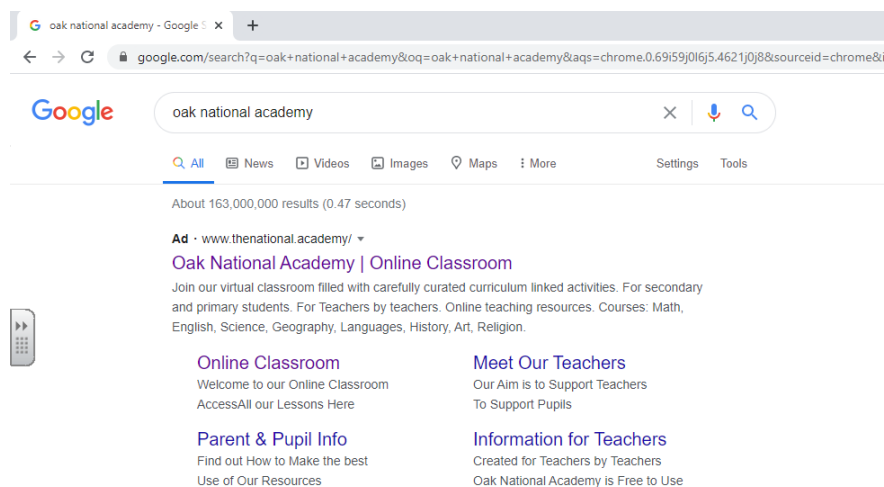
Dear parents/carers,

I sincerely hope that this communication finds you and your families safe and well. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of how our home school learning offer will look from the 1st June. As you will be undoubtedly aware, this date is when the Government have stipulated that Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 may return to school. We are altering the way we provide our home learning resources in light of this announcement to attempt to ensure consistency and equality of opportunity regardless of whether you have chosen to send your child to school or not. Please be aware that this process is continually improving based on ongoing research so we may also 'tweak' things slightly in future to improve the quality of the home learning work provided.

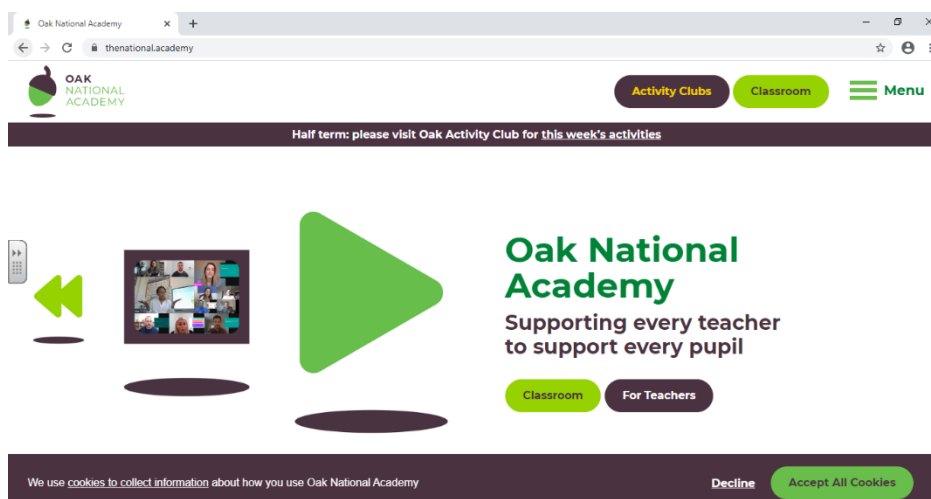
As a school, we have opted to use the Oak National Academy resources. These have been advocated for use by the DfE and by using them, we are providing a consistent entitlement for all of our children. **If your child will not be attending school from the 1st June, they will be accessing the same tasks on a daily basis as the children who have returned to school. The only discernible difference is that a teacher will be delivering the content at school.**

The Oak National Academy work usually consists of a pre-learning quiz, a video (recorded by a teacher who works for the Oak National Academy), possibly a worksheet and then a post learning quiz (these vary from year group to year group). The children and you will be able to see how your child has scored based on their work. There is not yet a facility for our teaching staff to be able to provide feedback but this is one of the 'tweaks' that we are currently working hard to resolve.

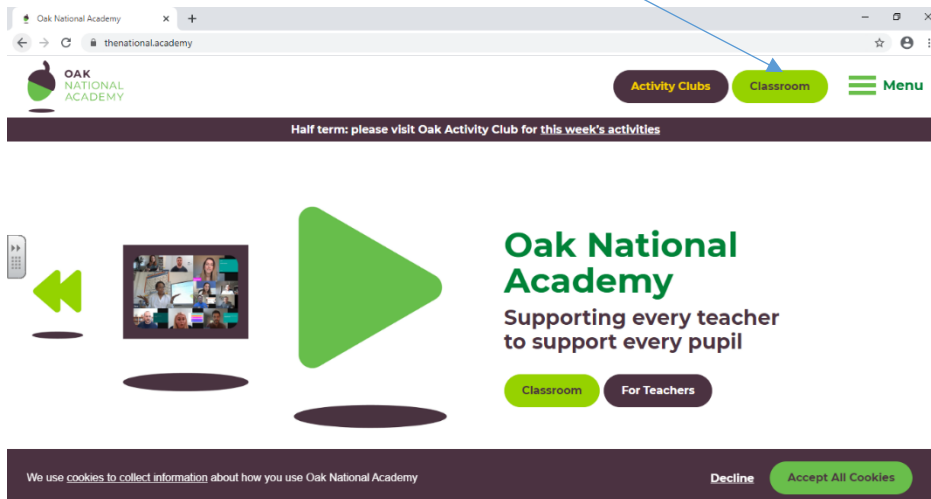
The simplest way to access the resources is to use Google Chrome and search for 'Oak National Academy'.



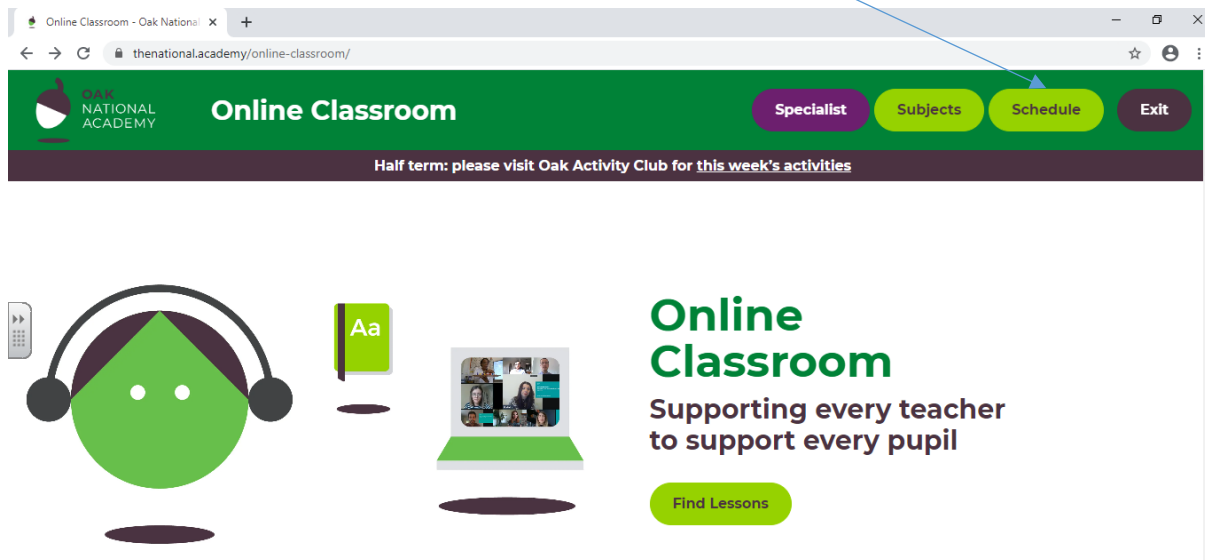
Select the top result.



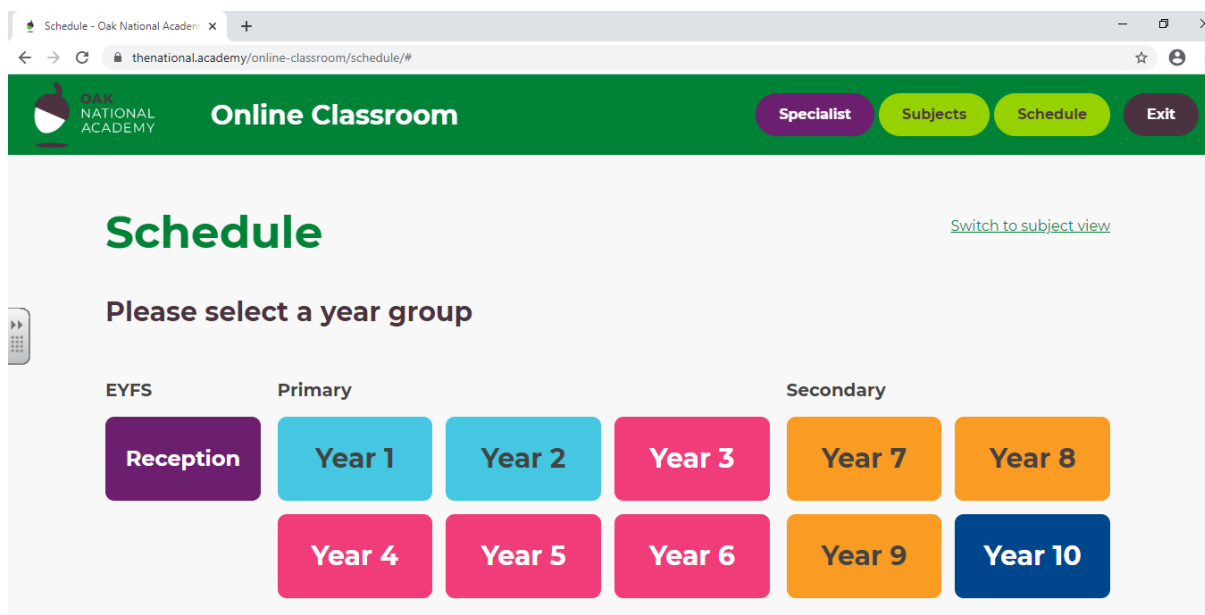
Select 'Classroom' from the top right of the window.



Once you have selected 'Classroom', select 'Schedule'.

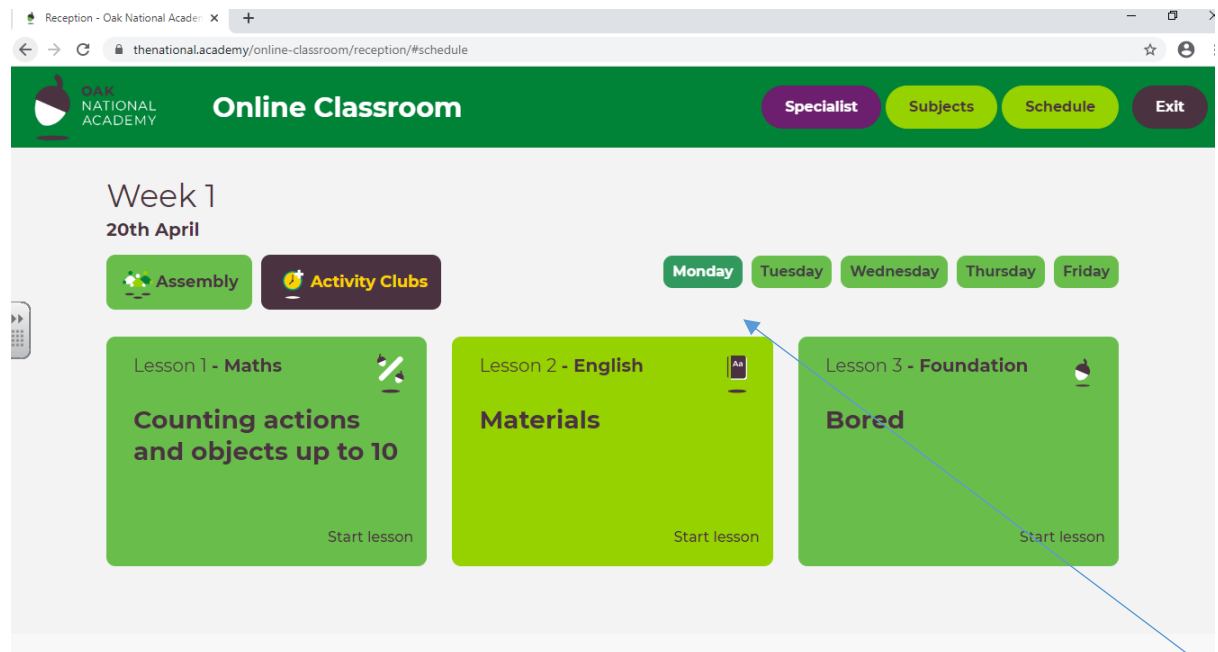


This should bring up the page below.



Now select your child's year group from the options available.

Once you have selected your child's year group, please scroll to the bottom of the page. Please note that these activities are dated from the 20th April. Both children attending school and those working from home need to begin accessing the content from the 20th April and it is essential that no lessons are missed as the learning is sequential and therefore must be completed in the correct order.



Please note that these lessons are organised by weeks with a different tab for each separate day. Simply click on the name of the day to access that day's three activities.

The other tabs on the page also indicate the other activities that are available-on this Reception page there is also an assembly the children can access.

Please ensure that your child completes all the relevant tasks on daily basis. If you encounter any difficulties with any part of this process, please contact the school office from the 1st June and we will provide as much support as required for the children remaining at home.
