Maths:

English:

Year 3: WB 18.05.2020

Maths:

1. Play a game of Fizz Buzz.
2. Choose 'fizz' for multiples of a number (e.g. 3), and 'buzz' for multiples of another number (e.g. 5). Starting with 1, players take it in turns to say the next number. However, each time a multiple of 3 or 5 is reached, the player must say 'fizz' or 'buzz' instead of the number. If the number is a multiple of both 3 and 5, the player must say 'fizzbuzz'.
3. For example: one, two, fizz, four, buzz, seven, eight, fizz, buzz, eleven, fizz, thirteen, fourteen, fizzbuzz
4. You could try other multiples or adding another multiple for a more complex game.

English:

1. Can you write a description of The Amazon rainforest? Make sure to include lots of fronted adverbials and conjunctions.

Science:
