3. Think about how you could tell people some of the story on the back but not too much or they won't read the book!

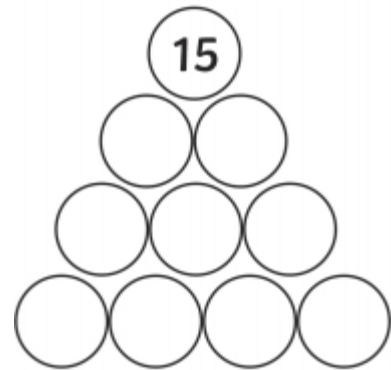
Art:
