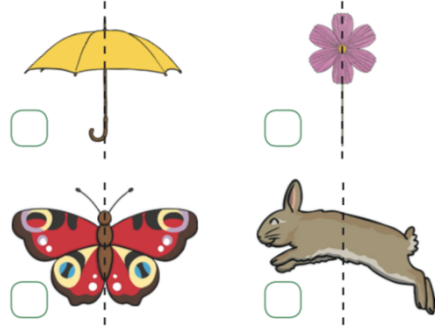


## Year 2: WB 18.05.2020

### Maths:
