## Coin Challenge

Put them in a row using these clues:

- The total of the first three coins is 27p.
- The total of the last three coins is 31p.
- The last coin is double the value of the first coin.



Take six coins: **two 1p, two 2p and two 5p.**

Put them in a row using these clues:

- Between the two 1p coins there is one coin.
- Between the two 2p coins there are two coins.
- Between the two 5p coins there are three coins.
