SCOOBY BOOM: A puppy blew up his owners' house after he chewed through a can of deodorant. A cute red setter called Barney was left alone for just ten minutes before he caused a terrible explosion so powerful it shattered windows, burnt floors and set a sofa on fire. The six-month-old pup had chewed through the can and, as its contents sprayed out, they were ignited by the heat from a lamp. The blast probably caused £2,000 of damage but Barney, along with two other pets in the house, escaped uninjured.

Owner James Brine said: 'Dogs chew everything. I was panicking about our pets and rushed home. We thought there had been a gas explosion.'

Prof Jim Flaggert, head of the Chemistry department at Sheffield University, said the deodorant was highly flammable. 'It is very dangerous stuff. These cans do come with warnings but obviously a puppy can't read those.'
