Maths

8 cans of cola cost £4.80



2 cans of cola and 3 cakes cost £3.60



How much does one cake cost?

Sally and Leon each have some money.
Sally has £80

- Sally spends $\frac{3}{4}$ of her money
- Leon spends $\frac{2}{7}$ of his money

They now have the same amount of money left.

How much money did Leon have at the start?
