### Percentages!

- 1) Find **10%** of **£60**; **15%** of **£60**; **45%** of **£60**; **80%** of **£60**
- 2) Find **1%** of **£140**; **21%** of **£140**; **36%** of **£140**; **72%** of **£140**
- 3) Jim bought two computer games for **£40** each. Later he sold them. He made a profit of **30%** on one. He made a loss of **25%** on the other. How much did he get altogether, when he sold them?
- 4) Jim bought another two games. He then sold them for **£60** each. He made a profit of **20%** on the newest one. He made a loss of **20%** on the other. Did he make a profit or loss overall?



**Challenge** – Find percentages of other numbers – ask someone to give you random percentages to work out. *Remember the key percentages to find first!*

## English

## Geography

Research the Amazon Rainforest and make a fact file.

You can present it however you wish (eg: leaflet/poster/PowerPoint).

Possible topics to investigate:

- Where is the Amazon Rainforest?
- Which animals live in the Amazon?
- What is the climate like?
- What is the risk of deforestation?
- What are the environmental benefits of rainforests?
- What is being done to protect the Amazon Rainforest? What more could be done?
- Why is it important that the Amazon is protected?
- Any other interesting facts?
