### **Mathematics**

This week we will be focusing on 'Matching'.

This week we begin Reception - White Rose Mathematics in line with the wider school's approach to teaching maths. Adult led mathematics groups will start to be a familiar part of our daily routine.

### **Mathematics Homework**

- On **Friday** children will bring home a maths game in a bag.

Games will cover number, shape, space and measure. Some games may be a challenge, others may be easier which develops confidence and consolidates learning. Please check and sanitise games before returning them to school.

- Games will be returned the following **Tuesday** morning.

This will give the game bags 72 hours to hang before being sanitised again and checked to make sure all the pieces are in the games ready for them to go back out to children on the Friday again.

- Please note if your bag is returned a day or two late your child will not get a new bag until the following week.

### **Communication/ Language and Literacy**

This week phonics learning will focus on letters 'Aa and Oo'

Phonics teaching will become familiar to our daily routine as the weeks progress. The children have already begun to take letters and sounds homework home inline with the work we will be teaching in school.

**Tuesday** –Sanitised books are returned and a new sanitised book goes home in the afternoon.

If books are returned after Tuesday the team are happy to collect them in. but your child will not be issued with a new library book until the following week.
