Theme – All about me

### 1. Play Matters

L.O. – For the children to learn through play

Start the day with 'Investigations' this is an opportunity for you to play alongside your child following their own interests using their own toys in the home. Talking with your child about what they are doing is very important for your child's speech and vocabulary development.

### 2. White Rose Maths

L.O. For the children to make simple patterns

View — 'Pattern Bugs' by Trudy Harris

This colourful and fun picture book is full of visual and verbal patterns

**Snack** – Provide a selection of fruit cut into small pieces. Encourage your child to make an edible repeating pattern before they eat their snack. They may like to build a fruit kebab pattern e.g. strawberry, pear, strawberry, pear, strawberry pear.

### 2. Phonics

L.O. – For the children to begin to form recognisable letter shapes

'Reporter'. Their job today is to find the letter 'Ff' around the home. Then have a go at writing that letter shape. Then draw a picture of something beginning with Ff e.g. fruit, fan, fork or themselves such as Freddie or Freya!

Evidence Their report drawing

L.O. – For the children to hear and say the initial sounds in words

'Photographer'. Their job is to use a camera to photograph objects around the home that start with the letter Ff. **Take one photo** of your collection of f objects gathered together to send to Ms Lilley.

## 4. Emergent Writing

L.O. For the children to explore what their hands can do

**Provide** opportunities for your child to explore what their hands can do.

Fine motor skill activity such as-

- rolling e.g. baking biscuits and rolling out the dough
