English

This week is our Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar week. During the course of the week, we will be focusing on skills that, **by the end of the academic year**, the children should include in their writing with little or no prompting. Today we will focus on spelling. The spelling focus is the sound 'shun', spelt with a 'sion'. Please review the PowerPoint on the school's web page-once you have identified the rule, create a revision poster (use the graffiti wall below-felt tips would be best) that will help you remember how each word is spelt! Practice these words throughout the week there will be a **test on Friday's Zoom!**

English-Reading

Mathematics

In mathematics, we are continuing to look at multiplication and division. Please watch the following video and complete the worksheet attached.

The children need to use their knowledge of place value (the value of digits within numbers) and partitioning (splitting the numbers into tens and ones) to be able to multiply using this method:

e.g. $42 \times 8 = 40 \times 8$ then 2×8 and both products (answers) added for the final product.

$$40 \times 8 = 320$$
 $2 \times 8 = 16$ $320 + 16 = 336$

Our Curriculum (1)

Last week, the children made a leaflet about their favourite place. In order to continue our topic, this week the children need to consider why people may visit different locations on holiday. The first destination I would like the children to research is the USA. Please consider the key question-Why do people visit the USA? Some children have already visited (Florida, Grand Canyon, Yellowstone etc) so they need to use this experience. I would like the children to research the USA as a holiday destination and create record (poster, leaflet, brochure, paragraph-children to choose) as to why people visit the USA-try include some specific statistics e.g. In 2018, 18.6million people visited DisneyLand etc. I have allocated two afternoons to complete this task.






