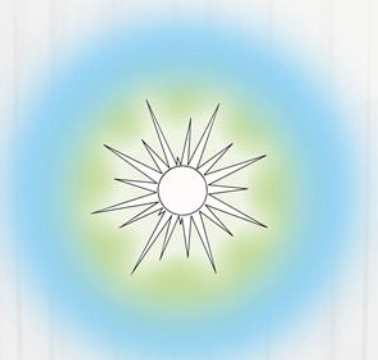


Words with the Ending /shun/ Spelt Using 'sion'

(Root Words Ends in 'se', 'de' or 'd')



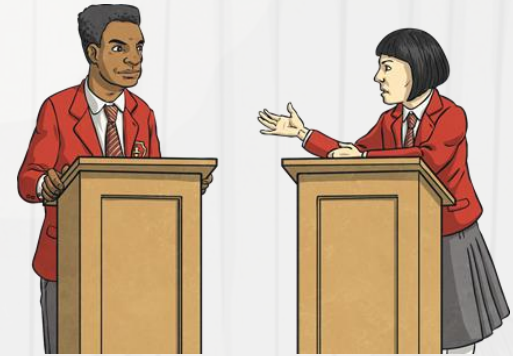
What Do You Notice about These Words?

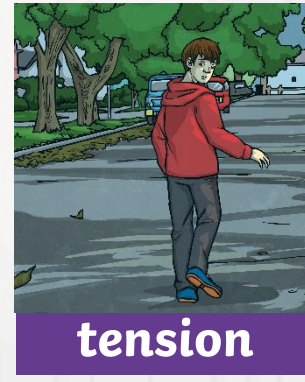
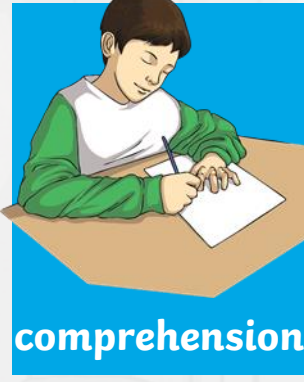
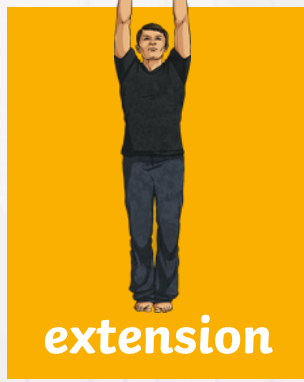
