## Collective Worship:

Thinking about yesterday's *thought for the day*, how do we get better at a skill? Today we are going to think about the difficulties in using or practicing our newfound talents and skills. A talented group of mountain climbers are trying to climb a never before attempted route up a mountain. Halfway up they come to a bit that is very difficult. They are secured to the rock, but attempt after attempt they continue to fail, falling into the safety of their ropes. The only way up to the top on this route is over the outcrop of rock they are trying to climb. They discuss it, plan it and persevere with it until one of the climbers manages the difficult climb and is able to attach a securing point above the difficult section. All the climbers manage to make it over the difficulty and complete the climb to the top. For many of us, talented or not, the achievements we make require us to overcome difficulties. The sense of achievement that the group of climbers had by climbing to the top was made even better because of the hardships they had to overcome. Resilience is the ability to continue even though times are tough, or you have failed in the past. Practise is a form of resilience, and resilient people are more able to overcome their difficulties and achieve their targets.

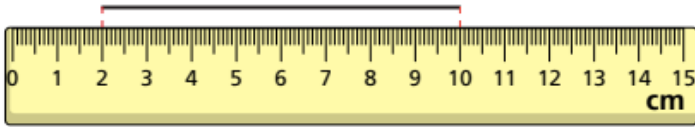
