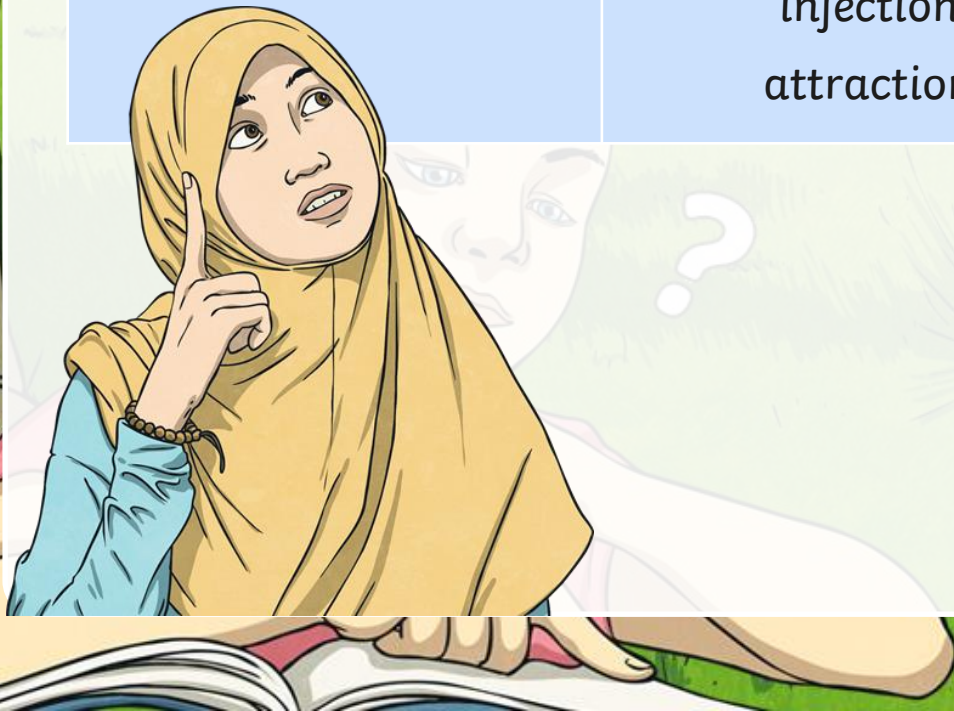
This week we are looking at words which end with the sound /shuhn/ spelt 'tion'...
