Science home learning 1st March 2021

We are now in the month of March! Lots of changes will soon be taking place. We will be learning more about this when we return to school. It won't be long and we will be able to see lots of minibeasts when we are outside.

Today I have planned an activity for you to develop your knowledge and vocabulary about minibeasts.

Can you move like a minibeast? To help I have attached a sheet showing a picture of each minibeast for you to take a look at. Before you start, discuss how each minibeast moves and practise:

- Scuttling like a spider
- Slithering like a snail
- Hopping like a cricket
- Creeping like a caterpillar
- Fluttering like a butterfly
- Buzzing like a bumblebee

After you have practised, play 'Guess the Minibeast' with your family - everyone takes it in turns to do an impression of a minibeast, while the others try to guess what you are. If your minibeast makes noises, you could do this as well as moving like them.
