Today I would like you to carry out an ice investigation!

I would like you to use ice to work out where the warmest place is, in a room of your choice.

You will need 4 cups and two ice cubes to place in each cup. Place each cup in 4 different places in the room of your choice. Look carefully at the ice in the cups and discuss its appearance and what you think is going to happen to it when you leave it for about 30 minutes. Talk this through with your adult. Can you explain why you think what you do?

Now, I have attached a picture of a set of gloves, hat and scarf. While you are waiting to look at the ice again you can draw and colour a design for your hat, gloves and scarf set.

When you take a look at the ice you have placed around the room - discuss what has happened and why with your adult. Where is the warmest place in the room?
