Dear parents and carers,

Here is your update for the week ahead. The children have continued planting in the edible garden including planting radishes and rocket in recycled pop bottles that we have attached to a pallet, secured to the garden fence. You may like to try this at home recycling plastic bottles into useful planters for the garden. We removed one side of the bottle and cut holes in the bottom part. The children then filled them with compost and planted the tiny seeds. You may like to share the story *The Tiny Seed* by Eric Carle with your child at home linked to our gardening work here at school 😊

Spring: Phase 8 – First Then Now

This week we will be thinking about – Spatial awareness (2)

For the children to:

- *Understand that shapes can be combined and separated to make new shapes.
- *To investigate how many different ways a given shape can be built using more shapes
- *Encourage the children to explore the different shapes they can make by combining a set of given shapes in different ways.

*To revisit all single sounds, digraphs and blends taught to date introducing consonant blends at the beginning of words - cl gl dr tw

*To blend a selection of cvc, cvcc words – cloth/ glad/ drops/ twins

*To revisit all HFTW taught to date.

*To introduce new HFTW – revisit (of)

*To make marks, hear and write initial letter sounds, write simple cvc words, begin to form captions and or attempt to write a simple sentence. Introduce features of narrative and extended sentences linked to our focused text 'Jack and the beanstalk'
