Welcome to Oak Class!

Dear Parents/Carers

I am delighted to welcome the children back and I am looking forward to teaching your child this year.

I would like to provide some information regarding this academic year and specific points to note as we progress through the Autumn Term.

## **Mathematics:**

In Year One in Maths this term we will be focusing on place value and addition and subtraction within 10 and 20. To help your child at home, you can practice counting to 20 and writing the numbers both in numerals and words.

In Year Two in Maths this term we will be focusing on Place Value, Statistics, Addition and Subtraction and Properties of Shape.

In addition to this you can practice basic maths skills at home e.g. telling the time using clocks and watches (you can watch the television until half past four) and practicing the value of money e.g. how much change will I get if I buy a chocolate bar with my pocket money.

## **English:**

In English this term we will be focusing on writing sentences with full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We will also be looking at writing recounts/reports, poetry and descriptions.

To help your child at home, you can practice letter formations (see attached sheet) of both lower-case and capital letters. This will help with letter recognition in reading and will help reduce letter reversal e.g. writing b instead of d.

### **Phonics:**

This year we will be following the Sounds-Write phonics programme.


In Year 1 in the Autumn Term we will be focusing on the following units:



You can help at home by regularly reading with your child. This will help them to develop essential confidence with reading. You can practice segmenting and blending at home (start off with just the sounds then say the whole word e.g. /m//a//p/ - map.
