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Pfizer jabs available for:

- * 1st & 2nd doses
- * Age 12+
- Minimum 12 weeks between 1st & 2nd doses for age 12-17
- Minimum 8 weeks between 1st & 2nd doses for age 18+

Pfizer boosters available for:

- * Age 16+
- Minimum 3 months since second dose

If you've had a positive COVID-19 test

You need to wait before getting any dose of the vaccine. You need to:

- wait 4 weeks (28 days) if you're aged 18 years old or over
- wait 12 weeks (84 days) if you're aged 12 to 17 years old
- wait 4 weeks (28 days) if you're aged 12 to 17 years old and at high risk from COVID-19

This starts from the date you had symptoms, or the date of the positive test if you did not have any symptoms.
