Date	Text Type	Activities
WB: 28.1.22	Narrative – Myths and Legends Children to use various myths and legends texts to focus on key features and to compose myths and legends in a similar style.	<u>Week 1-Reading week: wb 28.2.22</u> Children to practice and refine comprehension skills-inference, deduction, reading between the lines, interpretation, improvement, vocabulary development, summary writing etc.
WB: 7.3.22		<u>Week 2 - GPS week: wb 7.3.22</u> Children to focus on adverbials of time, subordinating and coordinating conjunctions, imagery, figurative language, personification etc.
WB: 14.3.22		<u>Week 3 - Writing week: wb 14.3.22</u> Children to compose a story with a message based on the history topic of Ancient Greece. Children to re-write, create their own myth.
WB: 21.3.22	Persuasion Children to text types (adverts, letters etc) to identify key textual features and then use this to produce their own persuasive texts for a specific purpose.	<u>Week 1-Reading week: wb 21.3.22</u> Children to be exposed to a wide range of diaries about a variety of subjects and topics-children to draw comparisons and differences between, identify key features of genre, grammatical features, audience and purpose of text. The children will also refine their reading comprehension skills with this text type.
WB: 28.3.22		<u>Week 2 - GPS week: wb 28.3.22</u> Children to focus specifically on language features and use of vocabulary, spelling of technical vocabulary related to subject, relative clauses, parenthesis etc.
WB: 4.4.22		<u>Week 3 - Writing week: wb 4.4.22</u> Children to compose persuasive texts focusing on using each key feature effectively and deliberately using vocabulary and grammatical features. Use of drafting and editing will be crucial during this week.
