School Meal eligibility check. As mentioned in this letter, the school receives additional funding (known as the pupil premium) for pupils whose families receive certain benefits. Registering not only provides your child with free healthy meals every lunchtime (for all their time in school - Year Reception to Year 6), but also raises additional funds for the school from the government.
