

tanley Family Hub Baby and Me Session

In line with the government's vision, Durham, has developed a Parent and Carer Panel which consists of both parents and professionals working together to coproduce support services to meet the needs of families and ensure our Family Hubs are warm, welcoming and non-stigmatising places for families to attend.

We have developed a comprehensive Start for Life offer which specifically refers to the antenatal period and up to a child reaching two years of age. All expectant and new parents will be provided with this offer in both paper form and digitally.

Family Hubs also offer a wide range of support for families with children aged 0 -19 years and up to 25 if the young person has a SEND. This offer includes one -to-one and group-based activities, as well as a digital programme offer.

Parents do not need an appointment; they are welcome to attend our Family Hubs at any time to find out what we have on offer. This could be coming along to meet other parents at one of our Baby and Me or Toddler and Me groups, or to receive infant feeding support, support for their child's learning and development such as their speech and language, access financial help and support or to access a parenting support programme.
