Welcome back. I hope you had a restful break. This half term the children will be focusing on 'Growth'. We will be learning to make our own compost, planting potato seeds that we will 'chit' on the warm windowsills in the classroom first, planting individual beans seeds and turnip seeds. We will be turning over the outside raised beds in preparation for planting soft fruit and salad vegetables.

We will be reading and re reading our core text called 'Compost Stew' by Mary Siddals throughout this theme introducing new vocabulary such as compostable, biodegradable, environmental, rot, stew, organic, decay and waste.

During Physical Development this half term we will be focusing on Coach John's Multi Skills Stations and during daily Maths Meetings we will take the children's mathematical journey to 20 and beyond.
